### Major Scale:

- Composto de dois tetracordes, unidos por um TOM:
  - De baixo: TOM-TOM-SEMITOM
  - De cima: TOM-TOM-SEMITOM




Figure 2.2.1 The D major scale on a keyboard




Figure 2.2.2 The D major scale in treble clef

- Toda escala usa todas as notas sem pular (apenas com acidentes)

### Major Key Signature:

- Aparece no começo de uma peça ou seção para indicar os acidentes da escala.
- Existem 15 major key signatures.





Figure 2.3.2 Major Key Signatures using Sharps
